<u>May 3, 2019</u>	Agenda deadline for May 23, 2019 Town Council meeting.
<u>By: May 9, 2019</u>	Initial decision to pursue general obligation bond referendum made; basic needs and plan (such as amount of bonds and purpose(s) to be completed).
<u>May 23, 2019</u> Regular Meeting	Town Council adopts preliminary findings resolution.
<u>May 31, 2019</u>	Publication of notice of intent to file an application with the LGC; Town submits notice to Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Local Government (if needed).
<u>June 7, 2019</u>	Agenda deadline for June 27, 2019 Town Council meeting.
<u>June 11, 2019</u>	File application with the LGC.
<u>June 27, 2019</u> Regular Meeting	Introduction of bond order(s) by the Town Council; file Sworn Statement of Debt and Statement of Estimated Interest with Town Clerk.
<u>June 28, 2019</u>	Agenda deadline for July 18, 2019 Town Council meeting.
<u>July 5, 2019</u>	Publication of bond order(s) as introduced and notice of public hearing.
<u>July 18, 2019</u> Regular Meeting	Town Council conducts public hearing regarding bond order(s), adopts bond order(s); adopts resolution calling for referendum.
<u>By: July 21, 2019</u>	Deliver certified copy of resolution calling for referendum to Board of Elections.

<u>July 26, 2019</u>	Publication of final bond order(s) as adopted and first notice of referendum.
<u>August 2, 2019</u>	Publish second notice of referendum.
<u>September 8, 2019</u>	Absentee ballots available.
<u>September 13, 2019</u>	Last day to apply for registration for voting in referendum.
<u>October 8, 2019</u>	Referendum.
<u>October 18, 2019</u>	Canvassing of referendum returns by Board of Elections.
<u>November 1, 2019</u>	Agenda deadline for November 21, 2019 Town Council Meeting.
<u>November 21, 2019</u> Regular Meeting	Declaration of results of referendum by the Town Council.
<u>November 29, 2019</u>	Publication of statement of results of referendum.
